

Grant Monck, LL.B.

After being called to the law societies of British Columbia and Ontario, Grant's fundraising career began in 1995 when he developed the planned giving program for the Canadian Cancer Society. Grant then headed the gift and estate planning program for the University of British Columbia and was Director of Development for Pearson World College for eight years on Vancouver Island. He became National Director of Ducks Unlimited Canada in 2011 and oversaw their \$500 million campaign in Canada to restore natural wetlands.

Grant established a private consulting firm in 2015 providing services in the areas of gift planning, government relations, major gift fundraising and strategic planning to not-for-profit organizations. Clients from Hong Kong to Halifax include community and hospital foundations, education, environmental, health, Indigenous, religious and social service organizations. Grant also holds the position of Senior Counsel with PGgrowth.

Grant is past Chair of the National Government Relations and Education Committees for the Canadian Association of Gift Planners(CAGP), past Chair of the Greater Vancouver CAGP chapter and was named a Friend of CAGP in 2016 for his advancement of strategic charitable giving on a national scale. He is currently a board member of the CAGP Foundation.

Grant has presented the CAGP Original Gift Planning course, Gift Planning Fundamentals course and spoken at National CAGP conferences since 1996.
