In 2005, Frank was appointed Canadian Ambassador to the United States of America where he was charged to navigate contentious bilateral issues related to trade and security. He has served on the Boards of CanWest Global, Noranda, Shoppers Drug Mart and General Motors. Frank was appointed to the Order of Canada in 2008 and is the recipient of eight honorary doctorates.
