<u>Planners (CAGP)</u> is a national association that is all about creating a better world through strategic charitable giving.








In 2019, we asked ourselves... what would happen if even a few more Canadians left a gift in their Will to charity. The answer? Billions of dollars for social good.

In 2020, Will Power was created, CAGP's public awareness campaign & the biggest effort in Canada's history to make gifts in Wills a social norm.




What we've seen in just 3 years




1.2M more Canadians have left a gift in their Will to charity, an expected **\$37B for social good!**
